Enhanced Language Training (ELT) program provides work or occupation focused language training to newcomers/immigrants to Canada who are assessed at Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLB) 6 or higher and intend to re-start their careers in Canada or work in a related field.

Canadian Workplace Culture and Communication

This course is designed to equip participants with the essential communication skills needed to succeed in a diverse and highly competitive professional Canadian workplace.

English for Office Administration and Customer Service

This course is designed to develop the essential soft and hard skills for a successful career in administration and customer service sectors.

Advanced English for Internationally Trained Professionals

This course is designed to enhance participant's English language skills in order to further their career in Canada.
